New Tour - Etna wineries tour and Silvestri craters discovering (Tour 16) WINE/FOOD TASTING INCLUDED (light walking + pedestrian path)

Vines have been cultivated on Mt Etna since the beginning of the Bronze age, as to say 4 or 5 millennium ago. The Greeks introduced new systems of cultivation and elevated wine to a deeply-rooted cultural phenomenon. Theocritus wrote about the vineyards on the slopes of Mt. Etna in the 3rd century BC. Despite the difficulties due to the volcano eruptions and the presence of fine sands in the soils that damage the vines, the wines produced today on the slopes of Mt Etna are of an excellent quality and were the first to qualify for the DOC designation in 1968. They include rosados (rosé's), dry white and dry red wines and are made mainly from Caricante, Catarratto and Nerello Mascalese, a deep colored black grape with spicy notes mostly grown in eastern Sicily. We drive first to Santa Venerina. The historic estate of Murgo, situated in a privileged position southeast of Mount Etna, has been making wines traditional to this territory since 1850. The volcanic soil give the wines a particular mineral taste typical of Mount Etna, as well as unusual finesse, aromatic complexity, and strong personality. The Murgo sparkler is made from the native Nerello Mascalese grape in the methode champenoise (the traditional method by which Champagne is made). Visit of the cellars and wine tasting. Then, we proceed to Zafferana Etnea, a beautiful little town several time involved in the eruptions of Mount Etna and we'll have a wine/food tasting of some delicious siciian products there. We continue the tour reaching the altitude of 6.000 fts (2.000 mts), we will have there another tasting of some sicilian wines, particularly dessert wine, in a very panoramic open space faced on the lava belonging to the more recent eruptions.

Than, before we take your back at your final destination, we offer a quick city tour of Messina or Catania (it depends on the place we start the tour).

The tour will start picking you up from the dock or other places you arrive. Messing was the most important port of departure for European knights on their way to the Crusades. Such a Crusade prompted the visit of Richard the Lionheart and King Philip II of France in 1190. Messing remained the second most important city of Sicily until the seventeenth century, when its position was challenged by Catania. The cathedral, with its very particular and spectacular astronomical clock (the biggest in the world) where Richard the Lionheart worshipped in 1190 en route to a Crusade, was erected during the twelfth century Norman dominion. Then we will visit a church with bronze statues (King Christ church) settled in a spectacular viewpoint, that's one of the oldest spanish fortress in Messina, from which to see the straight and the port of Messina, and take pictures of it. Tindari The second stop will be in Tindari (45 min drive highway). Ancient Tindaris is located on highground overlooking the Tyrrhenian coast about 60 kilometers west of Messina. Settled during the Bronze Age (circa 1500 BC), in 254 BC it became a Roman city. In 365 AD. Tindaris was one of the most important Greek city in Sicily. Following the fall of the Empire and the arrival of Christianity, its

importance continued, and in the 6th century it became diocesan see; the Sanctuary of the Black Madonna is Tindari's main religious attraction. The Saracens destroyed the city in 836. Tindari's amphitheatre was built in the 4th century BC. It has the ruins of simple temples and the so-called basilica, a fine example of Greco-Roman architecture begun in the 4th century BC and successively modified for use as a meeting place. There were also baths at Tindari, and some splendid dwellings. Then we will drive you to the dock or others places you prefer, in time for departure.

It is famous for its black Madonna statue that draws visitors from afar, and gives it its name, the Sanctuary of the black Madonna. Drive to visit CEFALù, a charming unspoiled village with winding, narrow, medieval streets and delightful restaurants overlooking a rocky coast. The most important monument is the Duomo of Cefalù which was begun in 1131 by Roger II and it was intended as the principal religious seat in Sicily. In the museum "Mandralisca" which houses an "Antonello da Messina" painting and a collection of coins, ceramics, vases, minerals and shells. Time permits, we may drive a little more along the coast line to get to the charming village of SANTO STEFANO DI CAMASTRA, filled of several ceramic shops and colored pottery, with bar, local restaurant and pastry. Visit Palermo, Monreale and Monte Pellegrino

The tour begins at the place and time agreed with the customer. Palermo is the capital and largest city of Sicily, in fact, is the administrative center and main tourist attraction of the island. Our tour today will focus on the most important part of the capital, that is, in its medieval area, where you can visit the splendid baroque and Arab-Norman sites in the city. A must is also the Cathedral: a magnificent and imposing building which stands on the ruins of the ancient cathedral, a mosque by the Arabs and consecrated to Christian worship by the Norman kings. Then, along a beautiful road that climbs the slopes of the Conca d'Oro, one reaches the village of Monreale. The Baroque Cathedral of Monreale, built during the Norman rule, will leave you speechless. We then let down again to Palermo, for a short walk along the colorful streets of the market "Vucciria", the largest of Palermo. If there is time, we move a few kilometers, up to The Sanctuary of Santa Rosalia, patron saint of Palermo; it is an important place of worship but also one of the most evocative monuments of the city, capable of moving famous writers such as the romantic poet Johann Wolfgang Goethe. One cannot remain indifferent in front of this church with a very particular structure, which can be reached by car along a winding road from which you can enjoy a splendid view of the city of Palermo or on foot with a long flight of steps. The church is built close to the cave where Santa Rosalia lived the last eight years of her life, forming a whole with Monte Pellegrino, the sacred mountain of the Palermitans.

First stop today is CEFALU', a charming unspoiled village with winding, narrow, medieval streets and delightful restaurants overlooking a rocky coast. The most important monument is the Duomo of Cefalù which was begun in 1131 by Roger II and it was intended as the principal religious seat in Sicily. In the museum "Mandralisca" which houses an "Antonello da Messina" painting and a collection of coins, ceramics, vases, minerals and shells. The squares, streets and churches of this medieval town are so postcard-pretty that it's no wonder director Giuseppe Tornatore chose to set parts of his much-loved film Cinema Paradiso here. Unfortunately, you won't be alone in admiring the honey-hued stone buildings, mosaic-adorned cathedral and dramatic backdrop of La Rocca (the Rock) when you visit - during summer, holidaymakers from every corner of the country flock to Cefalu to relax in resort hotels, stroll the narrow cobbled streets and sun themselves on the long sandy beach. The town is perfectly suited to slow, pedestrianised exploration. The little port is lined with narrow fishing boats and populated with local fishermen who can often be observed maintaining their boats, mending their nets and discussing the day's catch. The lungomare (seafront promenade) is very popular for the passeggiata (evening stroll), as is the main street, Corso Ruggero. Than we get back to Palermo, the capital and largest city of Sicily, in fact, is the administrative center and main tourist attraction of the island. Our tour today will focus on the most important part of the capital, that is, in its medieval area, where you can visit the splendid baroque and Arab-Norman sites in the city. A must is also the Cathedral: a magnificent and imposing building which stands on the ruins of the ancient cathedral, a mosque by the Arabs and consecrated to Christian worship by the Norman kings, than Royal Palace, the most ancient monument of Palermo, with ruins belonging to the Phoenicians age. Our tour ends here, customers will then be accompanied to the place and time they prefer.

The Myth: Erice and Segesta (Tour 11) (Easy walking + pedestrian path) Visit Erice and Segesta ruins

The tour begins at the place and time agreed with the customer. Today we cross

the western part of Sicily, our first stop will be, in fact, the archaeological site of Segesta. Maybe a turkish ancient settlement, the city of Segesta was a prestigious Greek colony, it was during the Greek period that Segesta became one of the most important cities of the western part of Sicily. At first we visit the Segesta greek temple, a temple in Doric style. The temple is composed of 36 columns, still intact despite earthquakes and bad weather suffered over the centuries. Very beautiful it's also the greek theatre, a typical example of a greek theater, semi-circular in shape. After the archaeological excursion, we head towards the mountain and precisely in Erice. Medieval town of Erice placed at 880 mt. above sea level. The remains of the ancient Phoenician city walls are the setting for a great little town; among the major attractions highlight we have: the Cathedral, built in 1300, in Catalan Gothic style, with refined decorations among which the icon of the Black Madonna, venerated a lot. It 'nice to walk the streets of the town and enjoy, in one of the many local shops, the famous sweet almond paste. Our tour ends here, customers will then be accompanied to the place and time they prefer.

Agrigento: the mythical temples valley and Scala dei Turchi reserve (Tour 12) (Easy walking + pedestrian path)

Visit the Temples Valley and Scala dei Turchi reserve

The tour begins at the place and time agreed with the customer. Situated on a plateau overlooking Sicily's southern coast, the ancient Akragas was founded in 582 BC by Greek colonists from Gela. The area we visit today is outside the walls of the modern city of considerable interest are: the Greek temples, theaters and the archaeological museum, which houses some of the findings of greater prestige. In the Valley of the Temples are the ruins of several temples, the necropolis, houses and all the original town plan of the ancient Greek colony. After visiting the archaeological area of Agrigento, time permitting, we head to the coast, exactly to the Scala dei Turchi, a cliff of white marl that rises above the sea along the coast of Realmonte, in the Agrigento area.

Over time it has become a tourist attraction both for the singularity of the cliff, white in color and with peculiar shapes, and following the popularity acquired by the novels starring Inspector Montalbano written by the Empedocline writer Andrea Camilleri.

Piazza Armerina and Caltagirone (Tour 13)

(Easy walking + pedestrian path)

Visit Villa Romana del Casale, Piazza Armerina and Caltagirone

The tour begins at the place and time agreed with the customer. Piazza Armerina is situated on a plateau almost 700 meters above sea level to about 35 km from Enna. Piazza Armerina was founded during the Norman rule, its historic center is full of beautiful churches, including the baroque cathedral, is also of considerable interest Spinelli Castle. The main attraction, however, the famous Roman Villa, with its magnificent mosaics. The Roman site is located a few kilometers from the town, the villa is one of the largest Roman patrician residences to have remained almost intact. Inside are precious mosaics depicting scenes of everyday life, such as hunting, games and gymnastic exercises. The villa was built between 330 and 360 A.D. and extends for about 3500 square meters. Our second stop today is Caltagirone, a few kilometers away from Piazza Armerina. Once an ancient Saracen fortress, the mountain town was rebuilt after the earthquake of 1693. The architecture of its churches is typically Baroque. Caltagirone is famous for its pottery. After a walk to the city center and visit the quaint shops of ceramics, we stop to taste the typical almond paste cookies. Our tour ends here, customers will then be accompanied to the place and time they prefer.

The first stop is the Church of Montalto, who houses one of the oldest icons of the Madonna and where you enjoy spectacular views of the city, the second stop will be the shrine of Christ the King, built during the fascistdictatorship, holds the remains of war deads, old paintings and fine marbles; from the terrace you can enjoy the best view of the city and the Strait of Messina. Continue through the ancient arch of the Spanish

era to reach the old city gate, a short stop for a couple of photos then, later, continue towards the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele, one of the most fascinating architectural buildings of the city. Before reaching the Cathedral, our ultimate goal, we will make a few stops to visit Pugliatti Square where you will find the Palace of Justice and the University. To reach the Cathedral we pass in front of the Church SS Annunziata of the Catalans and the Baroque fountains. We will also have time to admire the monument of Don John of Austria and then go to our final stop, the cathedral of Messina, with its spectacular astrological/ astronomical tower. The tour will end at the place and time you prefer.

On the trail of Commissario Montalbano: Literary tour covering the places described in Camilleri's novels.

Vigata and Montelusa are places that are imaginary and real at the same time: Porto Empedocle is Vigata with its streets, abandoned factories, Pasture, lighthouse, flat rock, Salita Granet, Marinella beach, "Commissariato" in Lincoln Street, Monte Crasto, Restaurant San Calogero and Trattoria da Enzo and Girgenti is Montelusa with the Commissioner's Office and Rabato district. We'll follow in the steps of Salvo Montalbano and the other members of Vigata's small police force. Mimi Augello, Montalbano's second-in-charge, Fazio, Gallo, Galluzzo and the incredibly stupid yet likeable Catarella, who mans the station's phones. The tour starts from the place the customer wish. We drive directly to the city centre of Montelusa (Agrigento): here we find the Commissioner's office (Questura) and Piazza San Francesco, the place where the very idea of Vigata came to Camilleri's mind. We walk along Via Atenea to the Santo Spirito Library where Montalbano finds the book that helps him understand the mystery of the Terracotta Dog. Transfer to Villaseta (The Snack Thief) and continue to Vigata, passing by the Pasture. Stop at the Tower of Charles V (described in Camilleri's first book) and at the pier to admire the sight of Vigata from the sea. Later, we walk in Vigata city centre to Salita Granet and Caffè Vigata with references to various works of Andrea Camilleri that are set there (The shape of water, The scent of the night, The terracotta dog, The excursion to Tindari, The voice of the violin). Leisure time to partake the small towm atmosphere which surrounds Camilleri's

characters. Continue to Marinella (Montalbano's house) and Scala dei Turchi, another place often described in the novels. The tour ends here than we drive the customer at his final destination.
